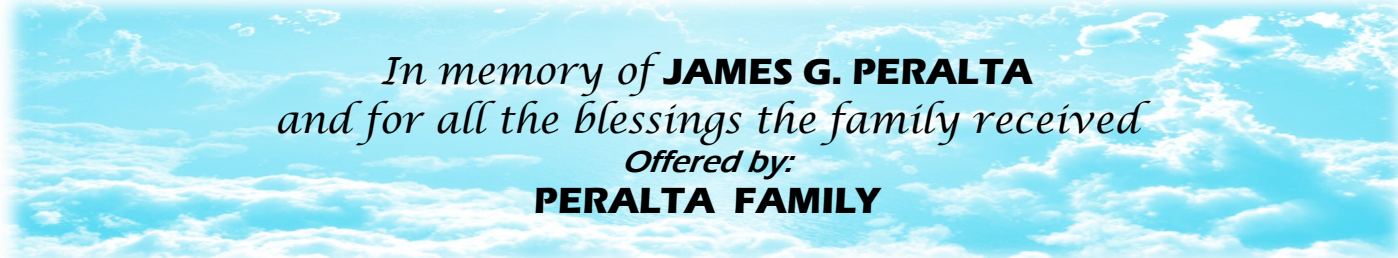


Parish Mission Statement

This Sunday marks the beginning of the new liturgical year. This season prepares us for the coming of Jesus at Christmas and at the end of time.

- **Hope in God’s Promise:** Jeremiah speaks of God’s promise to bring justice and righteousness. This reminds us to trust in God’s plans.
- **Faithful Waiting:** Jeremiah shows God’s faithfulness in fulfilling promises. We learn to wait with faith and patience.

BECOMING CATHOLIC...THE RITE OF ACCEPTANCE

For a while, a group of inquirers (people interested in the Catholic Church) have been meeting with the OCIA team here in our parish. During this time, they have explored their own faith journeys and whether the Catholic Church is the place to continue that journey. They have prayed about it and have decided to take the next step. This step involves a liturgical rite: the Rite of Acceptance (for the unbaptized). They will "assemble" publicly for the first time declaring their intention to the Church and the Church, in turn, accepts them as persons who intend to become its members (From the OCIA Paragraph 41).

We, the parish, as the Church, have a part in this Rite. We are asked to warmly welcome these catechumens into our faith family and to support them with our prayers.

This Rite will take place on Sunday, December 8, 2024, at the 9:30 a.m. Mass. We ask you to prayerfully and joyously participate in this Rite. Please take the time after Mass to meet and greet these people. They are embarking on a wonderful adventure, and you are a part of it. And please keep all of us, catechumens, candidates, parish sponsors, and team, in your prayers.
