## The Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

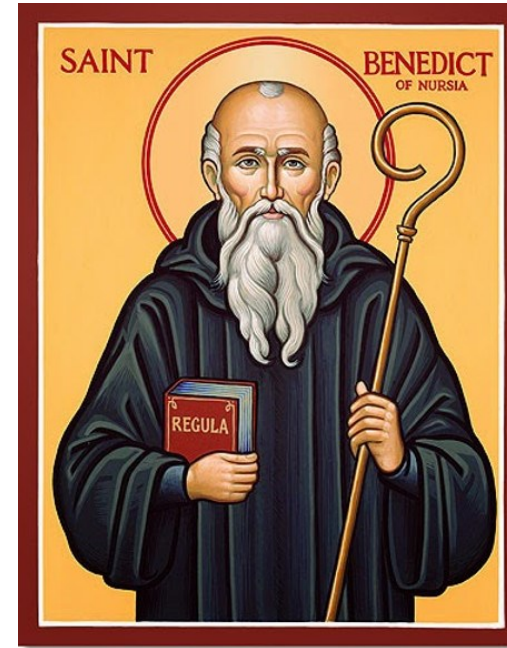
	<b>First Reading</b>	<b>Second Reading</b>	<b>Gospel</b>

The readings for this Sunday show us that God wants nothing but life and goodness for us, if only we will let Him rescue us. The first reading explains that God desires life for us, not death. The second reading tells us that God desires abundance for all of his children. And in the gospel, Jesus brings a young girl back to life and heals a woman who has been suffering for years.

This Sunday reminds us of God's desire for life and generosity. We see the importance of faith and the call to share our blessings.

- **God's Gift of Life:** God created life to be everlasting. Death came through the devil's envy, not from God.
- **Generosity Encouraged:** St. Paul urges us to excel in giving. By sharing our abundance, we help meet the needs of others.
- **Faith in Jesus:** A woman was healed by her faith in Jesus. Her faith brought her back to health.
- **Jesus' Power Over Death:** Jesus raised Jairus's daughter, showing his power over death. This reminds us of Jesus' authority and care.

These themes highlight God's love and our call to live with faith and generosity. We are invited to trust in Jesus and share our blessings.

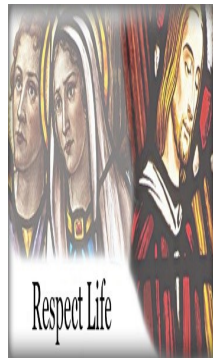
## Faith Formation
